Suggested clarifying the broader scope of the course. Apply to broader areas of life using health as a lens. Not career or professionally oriented class.

### Assessable assignment:

- Add description of scoping assignment to the assessable assignment instructions. Make it clear that the scoping assignment will be included in the final project.
- Align assignment with Core rubric. Include the core rubric at the bottom of the assignment file.

- Using any course in a category to meet a prereq requirement for courses outside of the core; work in progress for how to implement it; minimum grade requirement would be for any class in the category.
- Get a list of programs who are using a category as a prereq and distribute changes to the category (the sooner the better).

## TBC Outstanding Teaching in the Core Award
